<u>Scripture Passage:</u> "Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."

Introduction: Paul says to "throw off everything that hinders us and the sin that so easily entangles us" (Hebrews 12:1 NIV). Every day we have a chance to renew our mind in Christ. This allows Him to take all that hinders us so we can run "the race marked for us." These hinderances become sin that trips us up and slows us down.
