to start it. Boy he
burns me up.

December 4-35

Wednesday

This was our last day
on the new road.

Hung a tree up just at
quitting time.

We have to make up
our bunks army style
now.

December 5-35

Thursday

Started dropping
snags today.

We work in strips
like Blister Rust.

I'm working with
Rober.

December - 6. 35
Friday

It snowed pretty
hard most of the
day. Dropped a big
hemlock. 100 feet
high and four feet
thru at the butt.

December - 7. 35
Saturday

It snowed pretty
hard in the morning.
Walked to Clarkia and
mailed a package
home.

December. 8- 35

Sunday

It snowed and
rained all day.
Lay around the
barrack reading
and writing.

Played the violin
all evening.

December. 9- 35

Monday

Killed some more
snags.

Got on the "skin
list" for my bunk
today. This was the
first time.

Got my strings
from home.

December-10-35

Tuesday

Rain - no work
today. After inspection
lay around heading
all day.

December-11-35

Wednesday

Went back to
work today. It
rained about
quitting time.

Practiced music
tonight.

December. 12-35
Thursday

It snowed so we
worked in camp
laying gravel walks.

After much
discussion the orchestra
decided not to go to
Spokane because we
were left at loose
ends as to what we
were really going
to do and because
of lack of practice

December. 13-35
Friday

Back on snags
again today.

Robert offered me
ten Xmas cards if
I skinned up to the
first branches on a
tamarack tree.

After I came down we
dropped the tree
and measured the
distance. It was 45
feet.

December-14-35

Saturday

Worked today to
make up for Tuesday.

Photographers were in
camp taking pictures

for the Annual. After
we signed up for a

copy, numbers were
piped out of a hat.

December-21-35
Saturday

Left for Spokane, Wash. on
Kond Lane with Hank and
Willie. Got to St. Maries at
3:00 P.M. but the train was late
and we didn't get away
till 9:20 P.M.

Arrived in Spokane at
11:00 P.M. and headed for the
Y.M.C.A. We got our room
for four rates for 25¢ per.

Willie almost wrecked
the joint trying to close
the transom!

They have a swell
shower room here. all
marble.

December - 22 - 35

Sunday

Got up at 9:30 A.M. - after
washing went out and
etc. - went to the "Hof"
and saw the "French Folies"
Spent some time watching
the girl in the fish bowl.

Came back to the room and
lay around till supper
time - went to the "Granada"
and saw "Forbidden Heaven"

December - 25 - 35

Wednesday

XMAS DAY

Got up around 10:30 A.M.

went to the R.T.O. and
saw the C.C.C. picture

"It's a Great Life"

and "Seven Keys to Baldpate"

Turned in around

11:30 P.M.

December - 26 - 35
Thursday

Got down to the station at
9:30 A.M. and were told there
wasn't any train till 9:00 P.M.
We figured we wouldn't be
able to get into camp until
some time Friday and we'd
get fined \$3.00 for being A.W.O.L.

We went to a show to pass
the time away. Saw "Pillshanger's
Boy" and "Every Tub at Eight"

Got into St. Marie at 11:00 P.M.
Luck was with us. Our truck
was just getting ready to
go back to camp. We just
made it - I won the
mail contest with Mac Willie

December - 27 - 35

Back in camp again.
For Catalfamo went
home today. Went
to the canteen to get
my mail - got 16 letters
and cards - and three
packages - Got a
peach of a picture
from Virginia - the glass
was broken but the
picture was intact.
Wrote a letter for Johnnie.
