QUEEN CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

*Applicants must be between the ages of 6 to 18 . Age is determined on January 1st. She must also have a horse to ride, and enter at least one event in the Corning Jr. Rodeo. Sr Queen ages 13-18, Jr Queen ages 6-12

*Candidates are allowed to use only ONE horse throughout the competition. The contestants riding pattern will be provided in advance.

*Judging will be 1 to 15 points for personality, 1 to 25 points for horsemanship, 1 to 10 points for appearance and 1 to 50 points for ticket sales. Ties will be broken by the amount of tickets sold.

*Candidates will be judged on personality, appearance and horsemanship. They will be expected to sell 100 or more pre-sale rodeo tickets.

***Sr Queen** will be awarded with a Saddle, Silver Belt Buckle, Sash, Tiara and a Gift Certificate. All candidates will receive 10% of their ticket sales.

***Jr Queen** will be awarded with a Saddle Pad, Silver Belt Buckle, Sash, and Tiara. All candidates will receive 10% of their ticket sales.

All Queen results and awards are final by Corning Jr. Rodeo committee.
