- ◆ Task Force: Colorado Data Team members continue building SQL scripts to process data in the PosgreSQL database to generate several key metrics about questionable or inaccurate data items in the Colorado Voter Roll. This effort seeks to create a scorecard aligned with other states' scorecards to support the national organization, United Sovereign Americans (Marly Hornik).
