OPERATIONS REPORT

- From September 1, 2021 to August 31, 2022, the Borrowing Cupboard continued to operate within the Lake of the Woods District Hospital Covid-19 guidelines, masks, hand washing and enhanced cleaning protocols have continued to date.
- Ouring this time period we acquired a new cell phone and new plan as we were having issues with the old phone and the company we were dealing with. The good news was that it only meant a \$5.00 per month increase.

OPERATIONS REPORT (CONTINUED)

- Oln October last year, we met with our volunteers who shared what they felt was working with the program and made suggestions about how we could make improvements.
- Ouring the year we have operated with 5 on-call volunteers who have the phone for a period of two weeks at a time.
- We would like to train two more volunteers so we are actively looking for some new people to join these 4 valuable volunteers.
 - OVolunteers answer the phone, set up appointment times, meet the client to lend out, return or accept donations to the Borrowing Cupboard. This past year they answered 466 calls which was an increase of 46 calls or 10% over the year before, for an average of 39 calls per month. The months of March, June and July were our busiest months this year.

OPERATIONS REPORT (CONTINUED)

- This past year we had 184 borrowing transactions and lent out 310 pieces of equipment from the Borrowing Cupboard compared to 248 pieces of equipment last year or a 25% increase.
 - Four wheeled walkers, wheelchairs / transfer wheelchairs and bath seats were the pieces of equipment most in demand this year. Commodes, raised toilet seats, knee scooters and bed rails were borrowed each month.
 - The majority of equipment is returned within 90 days.
 - We sent out 36 Thank you's for donations of equipment over this past year.

OPERATIONS REPORT (CONTINUED)

- OWe have continued to a have a very strong relationship with the Lake of the Woods District Hospital Rehabilitation Department. This department has access to the borrowing Cupboard to lend out equipment and two staff, Brock Chisholm and Carrie Davies, are also valuable members of our Board. They help in the training of volunteers and in checking out what equipment is safe and good to lend out, as well, through the hospital they order any new equipment we need to fill low inventory.
- OWe also have continued to connect with the Vermilion Bay Lions Club as they have medical mobility equipment that they also lend out. They have taken specialized hospital beds, wheelchairs, mattresses, etc. that we are unable to store. If we have a client looking for equipment that we don't have, we connect them with this organization. We have also lent out equipment to residents of Birchwood Terrace and Pinecrest Home if needed.

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EQUIPMENT REPORT (CONTINUED)

- In 2022, we used donated funds to purchase wheelchairs, amputee cushions, lateral folding walkers, stationary commode chairs and knee walkers as these items are in very high demand.
- •In 2023, we plan to order wheeled commodes and knee walkers.
