Pine Box Derby (Casket Races) Saturday, October 13, 2018 Official Rules and Information

Entry Fee \$50 Business, \$25 Non-profit/Families/Friends

Build your own Casket Racer or Borrow one from Boo-Coda Spook-Tacular

The BOO-Coda Spook-Tacular Pine Box Derby (Casket Races) will take place in downtown Bucoda, Washington on Saturday, October 13, 2018.

Casket Races Teams must participate in the Hearse Procession (similar to a parade) as an entry. An announcer will read about each Casket Race Team. After the Procession, Casket Race Teams will proceed onto Pit Row and prepare for the Casket Races.

Timeline:

8:00am-10:00am	Registration, Casket inspection and set up in Pit Row
10:00am	Corpse Team Meeting (In front of Town Hall)
10:15am	Casket Lineup for Procession
11:00am	Procession of Hearses and Caskets (Judging)
12:00pm	Pit Row Lineup (Final Judging)
1:00pm	Casket Races Start
3:30pm	Award Ceremony (In front of Town Hall) or after last Casket Races, whichever is later

The following are the rules that govern the BOO-Coda Spook-Tacular Pine Box Derby (Casket Races) and all Caskets and participants must adhere to them.

The Pine Box Derby (Casket Races) should be seen as a marketing opportunity for businesses, government agencies, schools, and non-profit organizations. Friends and Families are also encouraged to put together a team and Cortege (Supporters) and have fun competing against other teams.

Each participating team shall provide a Casket conforming to attached “Casket Specifications” or borrow a Casket from Boo-Coda Spook-Tacular. Race officials will inspect all Caskets before the race. Caskets that do not pass inspection may not race. Any questions or disagreements will be forwarded to an event official. Each racing team consists of a minimum of three and maximum of five members: two-four Pallbearers (“Runners or Pushers”) to propel the Casket and one Corpse to sit inside the Casket. All members of the racing team, including Corpse, must be 18 or older. Cortege (Supporters) and parade participants may be all ages.

All Corpses must wear helmets during the race. Pallbearers are also encouraged to wear protective gear. Every entrant and participant shall conduct themselves according to the highest standards of behavior and sportsmanship. No Alcohol will be permitted on the premises.

All Pallbearers and Corpses must sign a “Hold Harmless Agreement” (an agreement which holds the Town of Bucoda harmless for any accidents or injuries) on the day of the race. Each team will receive the Hold Harmless Agreement at check-in on race day.

All Caskets, Pallbearers and Corpses, must be registered and be in the staging area by 10:00am. If you are NOT registered by 10:00am you will be considered a “No Show” and your spot will be given to a wait list team.

JUDGING and PROCESSION LINE UP INFO

Casket teams, Corteges and Corpses will be judged during the Hearse and Casket Procession and in Pit Row after the Procession. Arrive early to prepare your Casket for the Procession and judging. Participants are responsible for transporting their Caskets to and from the Procession and Pit Row. Casket Race Teams are permitted and encouraged to distribute promotional products during the Procession and in Pit Row. One member from your race team is required to attend the “Corpse meeting”. The Corpse meeting will be at 10am.

At the Corpse Meeting, rules, regulations and Procession and Race procedures will be reviewed. The Procession begins at 11am SHARP. All Casket Racers must participate in the Procession of Caskets and Hearses to compete in the races.

Lineup will be in the following order: Sponsors, Media, and Caskets beginning with number 1 and followed by the next team, i.e. 2, 3, 4 etc.

RACE RULES

The race begins when Procession is over and racers have moved to Pit Row for Judging, approximately 1pm. (Casket order #1 through last registered Casket team). The race course is approximately 300 feet long. The Caskets must stay in the Pit Row area until the awards ceremony. Each racing team consists of a minimum of three and maximum of five members: two-four Pallbearers (“Runners or Pushers”) to propel the Casket and one Corpse to sit inside the Casket. Pallbearers must hold onto the Coffin until it has crossed the finish line and stopped. Changing Pallbearers or Corpses during heat is prohibited. In case of injury, a race official shall have the authority to allow a substitute. Pallbearers will keep their Casket in their own lane. Pallbearers and Caskets may touch the yellow, but not cross over it. Caskets that cross the yellow line will be disqualified. Pallbearers and/or Caskets interfering with the other team as a result of leaving their lane will be disqualified. Protests can only be made by the race competitors. Protests must be directed to a race official within 5 minutes of the completion of the heat in question. Protests must be logical, reasonable, and based on sound evidence. Decisions by race officials are final. Each heat will pit two Casket teams against each other. The Casket Race Team with the fastest time will be the winner of that heat. Each Race Team will race a minimum of 2 times. The Caskets with the four fastest times from the qualifying Heats will run 2 final Heats to determine 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. 3rd and 4th fastest times and 1st and 2nd fastest times will race each other in the final races. (Race format subject to change)

RACE CASKET SPECIFICATIONS

The intent of the Casket Races is to have fun and provide an entertaining experience for participants and audience. Creativity is encouraged for the design of the Casket, Costumes of the Team and Cortege. You can provide your own Casket or borrow a Casket from Boo-Coda Spook-Tacular.

1. **SIZE OF CASKET:** Race Caskets should be a minimum 2 feet wide and 5 feet Long, and a maximum of 4 feet wide and 8 feet long. Overall width includes handles for pushing.
2. **WHEEL SPECIFICATION:** Each Race Casket must have a minimum of 4 wheels/tires that must be in constant contact with the road surface. Wheels are not to exceed 18" in diameter, including tires. Wheels must be within the overall dimensions of the Casket. Casters may be used. For safety and steering ability, wheels or casters may rotate or swivel.
3. **STEERING.** Steering mechanisms operated from inside or outside of the Race Casket are prohibited. Ropes for pulling Caskets are also prohibited.
4. **DESIGN.** Race Caskets are encouraged to have a logo, company/organization, personal names, or other types of decorations on sides, top or inside; however they may not exceed the maximum width and/or length of the Race Casket. We encourage you to provide a memorable name for your Casket Race Team, Casket and Corpse. Each Casket must have 4 Push Handles or Poles firmly attached. Front and Rear Push Bars are optional. No ropes are allowed.
5. **RACE NUMBER.** All Race Caskets must attached to the Front of the Casket the Boo-Coda Spook-Tacular Logo & Number, which will be provided by the Town of Bucoda at the time of registration. (Size is 8 1/2" high x 11" wide).
6. **SAFTEY.** Safety is IMPERATIVE! Race officials may disqualify any Casket they feel is dangerous.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will be in front of Town Hall at 3:30pm or immediately after the last race if the races go past 3:30pm. Awards are presented for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd Places and dead last, Scariest Casket, Funniest Casket, and Best Costumed Team and Cortege.
