

Confirmation Candidates Requirements

- Regular attendance at Sunday Mass (Saturday Vigil Mass)
- Regular attendance and participation at scheduled Thursday evening sessions, beginning at 7pm. Remember that attendance and participation at Mass is NOT optional.
- The Church is a servant community and all accepting full membership are also accepting the responsibility to serve. Therefore, candidates for the sacrament of confirmation are required to perform a **minimum** of **10 hours of Christian Service** during the preparation period.
 - October 2, 2022- Respect Life, Life Chain
 - o November 19, 2022- St. Francis Table at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception
 - o February 18, 2023- St. Francis Table at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception
 - April 7th 2023- Stations of the Cross Shadow Show
- Participate in two Reflection Projects:
 - o (1) A family service/outreach project that includes the Works of Mercy, such as;
 - Right to Life Chain (October 2)
 - Assist with (Soup Kitchen) (Giving Tree) (Coat Drive) etc.
 - o (2) A sacramental celebration project that manifests an understanding of sacraments and grace, such as;
 - Attend the celebration of a Sacrament
 - Baptism
 - Matrimony
 - Anointing of the sick
 - Participate in a Novena
 - Attend Adoration
- Attendance at the Confirmation Parent/Candidate Sessions.
- Celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once during sacramental preparation.
- A conscious effort to spend time each day in prayer.
- Attendance at the Confirmation Retreat (TBD)
- A free choice to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Dear Parents,

As part of the preparation for Confirmation we need to collect some information from you. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (No. 1213) "Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit.....and the door which gives access to other sacraments." Baptism is the beginning of our initiation into the Church. It is strengthened and nourished by the two other initiation sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist. The three sacraments together are called the Sacraments of Initiation.

If you do not have a copy of these certificates please contact the church where your child received these sacraments and they will mail you another copy. We must have a copy of these certificates on file in Our Lady of LaSalette parish office.

Selecting a Sponsor

Archdiocese of Atlanta Qualifications of a Confirmation Sponsor:

(These requirements are aimed at making sure that a sponsor is more mature, informed, and experienced in the ways of our faith and culture than the candidate).

- A sponsor assists the person, who is to receive Confirmation, to lead a Christian life
- There may be only one male or female sponsor
- A sponsor must have completed his or her 16th year
- A sponsor must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist
- A sponsor must be a practicing Catholic
- A sponsor must be free of any canonical penalty
- A mother or father may not be a sponsor for their child

The sponsor has an important role in Confirmation-supporting the candidate and the candidate's parents as the candidate prepares for Confirmation.

Qualities of a Sponsor:

- Already has a relationship of trust with the candidate
- Is willing to regularly interact with the candidate as he or she prepares to celebrate Confirmation and to help the candidate grow in his or her understanding of the faith.
- Is prepared to accompany the candidate on his or her faith journey after Confirmation
- Is willing to attend a morning/evening of reflection; rehearsal, and the celebration of Confirmation
- Is willing to participate in service projects with the candidate
- Is an older friend or relative in whom the candidate can confide
- Is willing to share their own faith experiences, including struggles they may have encountered on their faith journey

NOTE: If your Confirmation Sponsor is unable to attend any event, a parent or other adult may attend instead. If your Confirmation Sponsor is unable to attend the Confirmation Mass, a proxy may be used.

Please have your Sponsor complete the Sponsor Certification Form (previous page) in a timely manner.
