WHEREAS,	An act of the Congress of the United States (52 Stat 351; 5 U.S. Code, Sec. 87a) approved May 13, 1938, designated November 11 of each year as a federal legal holiday; and	
WHEREAS,	In 1954, at the urging of veteran service organizations, the Congress of the United States amended the Act of 1938, thereafter designating November 11 as Veterans Day to honor all American war veterans; and	
WHEREAS,	Wisconsin is the only state in the United States that has not designated November 11, Veterans Day, as an official holiday; and	
WHEREAS,	According to the U.S: Department of Veterans Affairs, there are over 350,000 veterans in the State of Wisconsin, and
