### What is our moon's real name?

The official name for Earth's moon is simply "the Moon". While other names like "Luna" (Latin) or "Selene" (Greek) are used in different languages or contexts, "the Moon" is the proper name used in English and by scientists in most scientific writings, according to Quora. The use of "Luna" is more common in scientific writing when distinguishing it from other moons.

It was created on July 29, 1958 when President Eisenhower signed the National Aeronautics and Space Act of 1958, paving the way for moon landings and other exciting space explorations.

The full moon in July is called the "buck moon" because July is normally the month when a buck deer 's new antlers appear. It is also when game hunting begins.
