WELCOME:

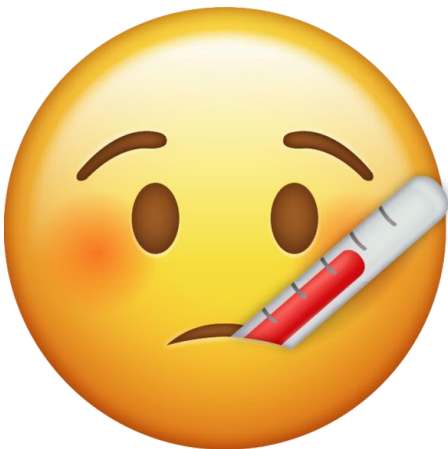
Welcome to our new CNA, Tracy. Tracy comes to us with many years' experience and we are fortunate to have her with us.
