- STEP 1: Check for available dates at: https://bit.ly/severance2
- STEP 2: Consider the various ways to visit Huatulco from now through mid-October (off season): https://mexicoliving.com/how-to-get-to-the-oaxaca-coast-this-season/
- STEP 3: The most economical way is likely a flight from Tijuana (CBX) to Huatulco with a short layover and transfer in Mexico City. Best way to search is using Google Flights: <a href="https://www.google.com/travel/flights">https://www.google.com/travel/flights</a>
- STEP 4: Once you have your dates set, contact Tom Severance by text at 760-419-7080 so he can insure an appropriate discount with Bayside Vacations Huatulco.

- STEP 6: Finalize your flight reservations. Several sites will be available often with slightly different rates.
- STEP 7: Review the CBX requirements: Note that you will need 1) Passport; 2) FMM tourist visa form (can be completed online): 3) CBX ticket (often less expensive purchased through the airline.) Travel for 7 days or less requires no visa fee.
