Huatulco

An oasis that Oaxaca gave to the world

Santa María Huatulco, aka Huatulco, was founded in 1789 and today is one of the most popular tourism resorts in Mexico and the world. It lies on the coast of Oaxaca and its main attractions are its 9 bays and 36 beaches.

In the nine bays of Huatulco: St. Augustine, Chahacual, Maguey, El Organo, Santa Cruz, Chahué, Tangolunda, Conejos and Cacaluta, you will find spectacular landscapes, favorable for extreme sports, ecotourism, alternative tourism, diving, mountain climbing, and bird watching. In the sixteenth century, these beaches witnessed disputes and raids by pirates and freebooters by Francis Drake and Thomas Cavendish.

Today, Huatulco is characterized as an international cruise destination which houses an excellent hotel infrastructure and services 3, 4 and 5 star hotels, as well as a variety of restaurants where you can discover or rediscover the exquisite Oaxacan cuisine, nightclubs, 18-hole golf courses and one spectacular 27,000 acre National Park, declared a natural protected area. In 2005, Huatulco was the first destination in America to obtain the Green Globe International Certification.

Visit the Bay of Santa Cruz: it has a pier from where several motorboats, sailboats and yachts take trips around the other eight splendid bays. The bay has a dock specially designed for cruises and if you're lucky, you can chat with passengers that come from all corners of the world. The best thing to do is to walk along the charming main square lined with stalls, a craft market and a commercial center, with many restaurants, bars and nightclubs.

Part of the appeal of Huatulco, in addition to its 28 degrees celsius average temperature (82 degrees fahrenheit), is its proximity to traditional ports such as Puerto Escondido and Puerto Angel. Huatulco is 277 km (172 miles) from the state capital of Oaxaca City (named Best City in the World by Travel & Leisure World), and 50 minutes from the city of Mexico (Mexico City) with Volaris. What more do you need to visit this paradise?
