

Instructions for GBA 1000 Yard Nationals

We are only a few weeks away from the first GBA USA 1000 Yard Nationals. If you have not yet registered, please do so right away. Registration materials are available on our web site <u>https://globalbenchrest.com/</u>

Registration cut off date is for applications <u>received</u> by Sunday August 10.

- Friday August 16: Pick up your check-in materials at the range. The range will be open for sight-in from 10 am until 5 pm.
 - Sighting-in on clay pigeons is free, targets are \$10 each.
- Saturday and Sunday August 17 and 18: Late check-in at 7:30 am and then Competition with a great bunch of long-range shooters

Administrative notes:

- We will have cooks at the match serving breakfast and lunch at a reasonable cost.
- A security guard will be on site throughout the weekend
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the range at any time
- We will start shooting at 9 am each day
- After you have unloaded your gear, please move your vehicle to the grass parking area located toward the road
- We have a covered area just behind the firing line where you can set up a cleaning table. You can also bring your own canopy

Please note the following items:

- We strongly encourage you to get to the range on Friday to check-in. Light Gun weigh-in should be done then if at all possible.
- If you are checking in on Saturday morning please get to the range by 7:30 am and also weigh your Light Gun at that time

- Complete rules are available on our web site, here are a few reminders:
 - All shooters must remain at the line and on your bench until the line is called cold at the end of your relay
 - No bolts in guns until instructed to insert them at the line.
 Bolts must be removed at the end of the relay
 - Heavy gun weight is unlimited, except that one shooter must be able to carry the rifle to and from the line in the as-fired configuration. This one person does not have to be the shooter
 - We need to keep things moving as we change relays. If you are slow, we will have folks help you to clear your bench and move your equipment to the tables behind the firing line. Please don't take offense at this.
 - It is recommended that you have a buddy help you with set up, again, to keep things moving.
 - The tables at the back of the firing line are only to be used when staging your equipment for the next relay, and taking your equipment off the line
 - Rests and equipment may be stored in front of the firing line as long as they do not block access and are below the top of the benches
- Course of Fire: Three target aggregate for each rifle class. This course of fire may be changed based on weather conditions and final registration numbers. We must finish the match by the end of the day Sunday.

 - We have a really nice prize table. The top placing shooters as defined at the match will select prizes from the prize table. The balance of prizes will be awarded by random drawing.
