



RÍO LAGARTOS LAS COLORADAS RIVER SAFARI

We will begin our tour by visiting Las Coloradas, where you will see several bodies of water used in the salt production process, some of them featuring a striking pink color.

Río Lagartos is a small fishing village located within a protected natural reserve—one of the true natural treasures of the Yucatán Peninsula. Here, we will enjoy a boat ride through its mangrove-lined channels, where you can spot bird species such as pink flamingos, herons, eagles, pelicans, and cormorants.

As part of this adventure, you'll experience a Mayan Bath, covering your body with nutrient-rich clay. Afterwards, we will head to a virgin beach to rinse off the mud in its crystal-clear waters—the perfect ending to this exciting experience.
