We will then head to the Chocolate Museum "Choco-Story," an interactive space where you can immerse yourself in the history of cacao—its origins, its spread around the world, and the many uses given to it by ancient cultures. Here, you'll discover the traditional Maya methods of preparation that have endured through time.

To end on a high note, we will enjoy a unique experience in a cavern-type cenote, a mystical natural sanctuary perfect for cooling off and embracing the magic of Yucatán.
