

Experience an exciting tour of the most memorable spots in Yucatán, starting the day with a delicious breakfast of huevos motuleños in the Magical Town of Motul. We will continue our journey by visiting Hacienda San Eduardo, one of the last remaining henequen haciendas.

Next, we will head to one of the most prominent Mayan ceremonial centers in the area, surrounded by mangroves at Xcambó.

We will then move on to a traditional saltmine called Xtampú, where you can enjoy birdwatching opportunities, including sightings of cormorants and flamingos. To wrap up the tour, you will have 2 hours of free time at the Puerto Progreso boardwalk, where you can admire the longest port in the world and enjoy the views.
