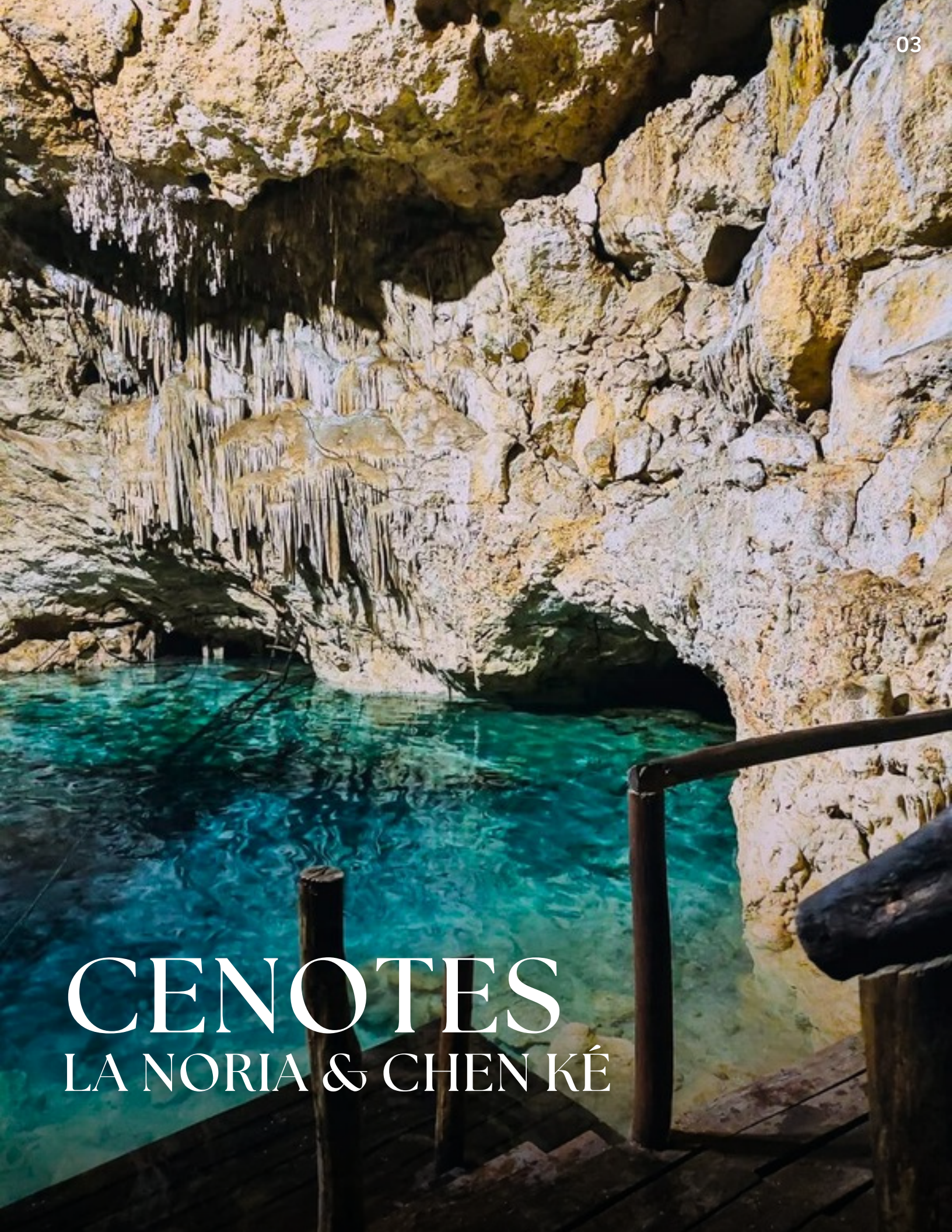

LA NORIA & CHEN KÉ



The La Noria and Chen Ké cenotes are part of the natural and cultural legacy of the Maya region. These geological formations, created by the collapse of underground caves, were considered sacred places by the ancient Maya and gateways to Xibalbá, the spiritual world.

Today, both cenotes retain an atmosphere of reverence and connection with nature. La Noria stands out for its crystal-clear waters and open surroundings, perfect for swimming and enjoying the tropical landscape, while Chen Ké offers a more intimate experience, surrounded by vegetation and rock formations. Together, they represent not only the natural beauty of Yucatán but also the profound relationship the Maya culture maintained with water as a source of life and a symbol of purification.



MAYAN CAVE ROCK PAINTINGS

Deep within the Kixné Cave lie enigmatic Mayan rock paintings, a silent testament to the spiritual connection between this civilization and the subterranean world. Painted on the rock walls, these depictions illustrate symbolic scenes and rituals that, according to specialists, were associated with ceremonies dedicated to the deities of water and nature.

Their location within a sacred cave highlights the importance of these spaces as sites of worship and connection to Xibalbá, the Mayan underworld. More than mere artistic expressions, the Kixné paintings offer a window into the religious beliefs and profound respect the Maya had for the elements that sustained life.
