Meet Dani Sussman



A Colorado native, Dani started riding at the age of six and joined the United States Pony Club at the age of nine. She successfully became an 'A' rated graduate in Pony Club and thus began her passion for Three-Day Eventing.

In 2003, Dani began working for and competing with Amy Tryon, two-time Olympian, Olympic Bronze Medalist, and World Equestrian Game Team Gold Medalist, in Duvall, Washington. She travelled extensively with Amy both as her groom and also as a fellow eventing competitor.

Since 2001 Dani has been professionally training and teaching all levels of horses and riders. She owns and operates Aspire Eventing in Larkspur, CO where she is based most of the year. She has carefully brought her current partner, Jos Bravio up to the 4 * level and is now qualified to ride at the 5* level. Dani and Bravi finished 10th at the Land Rover Kentucky 3 Day Event in 2024 – a huge accomplishment! She is also currently competing the stallion, RR Simple at the 3* level.

Dani is currently adding to her professional skill set by participating in the USEA Eventing Coaches Program. She actively trains with Buck Davidson (eventing) Sue Martin (dressage) and Mariano Bedoya (stadium jumping). She will be competing this winter on the East Coast.
