PBEA Membership NOT Required on Sunday during Show Jumping/Derby, but appreciated

What is a Derby? Simply ride a partial show jumping course – go out to the cross country course & jump some fences, returning to the show jumping course to finish up with a few more show jumping fences. There will be divisions of Intro (2'), Starter (2'3"), Beginner Novice(2'6"), Novice (2'9"), & Training (3'3"). The Show Jumping fences in the arena will be set at those appropriate heights.

The SJ course will be set by Saturday by 6 PM & you can walk either on horseback or on foot prior to Sunday at 8:45.

XC field open for course walk until 10:30 AM Sunday. XC field must be cleared of horses, walkers and dogs by then for the safety of riders after 10:30 AM!

If you do NOT want to go out cross country or want to do extra show jumping rounds without the "derby" element that will be an option.

Show Jumping Courses: Piles of Poles, CrossRails (2'), .70 (2'3"), .80 (2'6"), .90 (2'9"), 1.0 (3'3"). Warmup will be held prior to rounds and after division is raised (2 - 3 fences)

You may engage in multiple rounds at the same division and/or move up as a course level is changed.

Get on list and line up at the entrance gate as the division opens/changes
