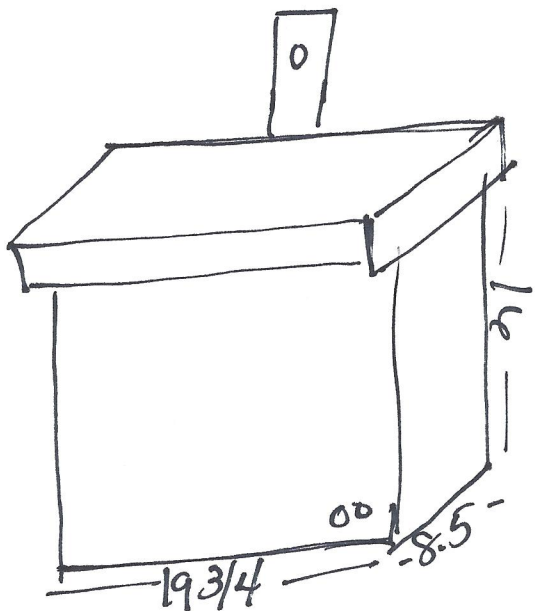


# Swarm Trap



1 - half inch plywood sheet  
2 - 1 x 2 boards - non treated  
optional - 2 small blocks - just  
scraps 2x4 work great  
1 scrap of pallet wood  
exterior paint green or Brown

## Plywood cuts

2 boards  $19\frac{3}{4} \times 16$  Front & Backside  
2 boards  $8.5 \times 16$  - sides - exterior sides  
2 boards  $8.5 \times 15$  sides - frame rest  
1 board  $8.5 \times 17\frac{3}{4}$  bottom  
1 board  $22 \times 11\frac{3}{8}$  top lid

## 1x2 Boards

2 length of 22

2 length of  $9\frac{1}{2}$

Front Board cut two  $\frac{3}{4}$  holes near the bottom for the bees entrance

Back Board (optional) if you want to hang them. Screw the two small scrap blocks on the scrap pallet wood. Then cut a  $\frac{3}{4}$  hole to hang it on. Then from the inside of the Back screw the two blocks and

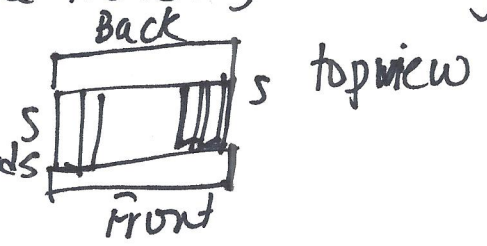


hanger

The sides - assemble by gluing the 8.5 x 16 to the 8.5 x 15 side boards. Staples help hold it together.

Attach the sides to the inside of the front & back by glue and stapling

then glue to 8.5 x 17 3/4 bottom boards  
on staple it good.



The lid will be with the 22 length and 9 1/2 as a frame the small piece are inside the longer ones.  
glue & staple

Then place the 22 x 11 3/8 top board with glue & staples to the frame.

When all assembled paint with exterior paint to make them last longer.

When Dryer hang up.

They hold 6 deep frames with free space below.
