The Bloomsburg Food Cupboard



A Warm Welcome

Twenty-six years ago, the Bloomsburg Food Cupboard (BFC) was created using the taxexempt status of St. Columba Catholic Church. Due to this organizational structure, the BFC had to keep its accounts and donor funds with the Harrisburg Diocese. Over time, both the BFC and St. Columba realized that it would be in the best interests of both parties for the BFC to become its own 501c3. This change expedites the availability of donation funds and allows us to operate independently.

This long process was supported by St. Columba pastors,
Monsignor Lawrence and Father
Mowery. In 2021, the BFC became an independent nonprofit entity.
St. Columba continues to provide immense support to the food cupboard administratively and of course, physically. We now have a Board of Directors which meets regularly to ensure our continuity. Thanks to our new status, we have also been able to hire our first paid staff member, Lynn Smith.

How It's Going...

Our backpack program served approximately 265 families in the Bloomsburg Area School District and St. Columba School each week of the school year. As we finished 2022, we were providing food for around 325 families. This includes over 800 individuals, which shows a marked increase from the previous year. We continue to receive weekly donations from Giant, Weis, Walmart, Bloomin' Bagels, Panera, Olive Garden and KFC. The return of the Post Office Food Drive garnered 7,676 lbs of donated food! These large donations have been combined with personal donations and donations from BU to provide our clients with healthy food twice each week.

Update on current procedures

As many of you know, the pandemic necessitated a change in how we deliver food to our clients. Clients remain in their cars and place their order with one of our volunteers. As clients drive through the line, other volunteers pack their order and place the order in the client's trunk when they reach the end of the line. We plan to continue this method of food delivery as we consider a few new additions to make the process even smoother. We will soon be implementing a new computer system to improve our registration and reporting capabilities.
