



Bike Loudoun Goals for 2016-2020

1. Fully implement Leesburg Loop Bikeway
2. Initiate, identify funding and complete dedicated Bike/Hike Trail between Ball's Bluff and White's Ferry
3. Advocate for formal Loudoun County Trails/Bike/Blueways Committee involvement – now via Stakeholders Committee of Comprehensive Plan
4. Ensure bikeway access to new Metro Stations & other critical commuter areas
5. Develop signed bikeways esp. in western Loudoun to create Potomac Heritage Trail Bikeways Network routing along historic and tourist destinations
6. Plan and implement the proposed "Off-Road Path Corridor: Bluemont Connector" which connects with W&OD Trail at Purcellville (agreed in 2003 County Comprehensive Plan)
7. Require/increase bike parking and racks at office buildings, schools, shopping, and transit stations
8. Improve outreach programs to schools and community groups to promote bicycle safety and education, working with Safe Routes to Schools
9. Fill Loudoun County Bike/Ped Coordinator position (completed Sept 2016)

New Bike and Hiking Trail to connect White's Ferry to Ball's Bluff

- This Trail would extend from new Leesburg Loop Trail to White's Ferry to connect W&OD and C&O Canal Path
- New VDOT Project to reduce congestion at Rt.15 Bus / 15 Bypass could be umbrella project for Trail
- FLAP (Federal Land Access Program) and Fed TAP could provide funding as well as State Sources
- New trail envisioned as much more than Shared Use Path along 15
- New Trail Park could be maintained, by Loudoun county Parks or NOVA Parks
- Park would extend from Ball's Bluff to White's Ferry Boarding Site




Potential White's Ferry to Ball's Bluff Bikeway Routes

White's Ferry


Loudoun County has 20' Easement along White's Ferry Road on Big Spring HOA land, negotiation started

Solid Lines = Separate Shared Use Path Paved 10' wide
-  Alternative 2 West Side of Route 15
-  Potential Bike Ped Bridge over Route 15 at abandoned Balls Bluff Cemetery Road




Abandoned Balls Bluff Cemetery Road now owned by Potomac Crossing HOA, with trail easement by NOVA Parks

HOA Subdivisions in area of White's Ferry and Route 15




Leesburg Loop Bikeway Project approved by Town Council and in implementation phase

- New Bike lanes on Plaza Street painted in August, 2015, first lanes in Loudoun County!
- Town Council unanimously approved Phase 1 of Plan on October 13, 2015 after full support from Town Planning Commission and Town Parks and Rec Commission
- Provides linkage between W&OD & Ball's Bluff
- Various Loops for various distances

 Construction starts Fall 2017, Completion Spring 2018, New Signal & extended Shared Use Paths
