Notice to Lytton First Nation community members:

Lytton First Nation Chief and Council is taking this opportunity to inform the community members in Lytton, that there is a COVID-19 outbreak in the area. Seven cases have now been confirmed and five more identified, with contact tracing in progress. The extent of this outbreak is unknown at this time.

We strongly recommend community members who have symptoms such as a cough, fever, loss of taste or smell, difficulty breathing, chest pain, or have been in contact with a COVID-19 positive case, please make an appointment with your nearest COVID-19 testing facility, which are provided below. There has been plenty of travel between communities lately, which may have compounded the issue. Hotel and camp accommodations are confined spaces with many community members congregating in the shared spaces. These are prime conditions for transmission to occur, if precautions are not taken.

Masks, hand sanitizing, and social distancing is heavily recommended at this time. Lytton First Nation is working with health authorities to determine the extent of this outbreak, so we can provide the necessary assistance where required. Your patience and understanding is greatly appreciated in this trying time. Thank you.
