The objectives of the Social Housing Program are to fulfill its commitment to provide better living conditions for the Members of Lytton First Nation, while operating in accordance with clear business principles and remaining fiscally responsible and accountable to its membership.

This program is based on the following principles:

- That Membership is provided assistance in the provision of their basic rental housing needs on reserve.
- That continuous effort is made to achieve steady improvements in the quality of living on Reserve.
- That the Lytton First Nation housing program be administered in a cost-effective, service-oriented and accountable manner.
- That the Band Membership, Council, and Housing Administrator will abide by the Housing Policy Manual.
- That all members be treated in a fair and equal manner in the distribution of both Residences and Lots.
- That the members who rent or lease a house from the Band have a responsibility to abide by this Housing Policy Manual.
- That the administrative infrastructure be separated from the political governance of the Lytton First Nation.
