The Education Manager will oversee the general operation of the Education Department. This position will work with the Education committee and Regional School Districts when required.

### PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Preparing budgets, proposals, reports, and expenditures. Ability to secure funding, organize education staff meetings, chair the weekly education committee, prepare inclusive department monthly reports for the community newsletter, and for Council. Monitor costs and expenses to make appropriate decisions for the department. Create sound work plans for the department through strategic planning and or CCP.
