Working in various locations including the sawmill site, Lot 47, and other sites that may be determined. Reporting to the Economic Development and Implementation Managers, the Crew Lead will coordinate the laborers in safe and productive Sawmill operations in our Firewood Bundles/Kindling, Rough-cut Lumber and Composting projects.

This is a Targeted Wage Subsidy Sawmill Operations Project.

#### Qualifications include:

- Chain Saw Safety Certified, valid ticket required for Power Saw operator(s)
- ATV experience is an asset. Successful candidates will take ATV Safety training courses
- Experience with small to medium sized machinery is an asset
- Experience with portable sawmill (Wood Mizer LT 15, and Alaskan Sawmill) is an asset
- Experience with a portable Firewood Splitter is an asset
- Experience with a portable Woodchipper is an asset
- Experience working outdoors in all possible weather conditions is an asset
- A Valid BC Driver's license and clean abstract is an asset
- Experience supervising a crew will be considered
- Must be a team player

#### Duties include, but not limited to:

- It will be everyone's responsibility to keep the work area clean and safe to work around
- Watch your co-workers back and tell your supervisor/Manager if you see anything unsafe
- Help to safely set up/operate/move any of the machines
- Follow directions and specifications required for all projects
