EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY TI'Kemtsin Community Health Driver

Lytton First Nation (LFN) is currently recruiting drivers for the TI'Kemtsin Community Health Team. There will be trips outside of Lytton, as well as transportation needed within the community to help elders and LFN members get to and from scheduled appointments. The driver must maintain a cheerful disposition for all trips and is responsible for providing safe and reliable transportation. The driver must have great interpersonal skills to effectively communicate with all ages, maintaining professionalism and privacy of all clients within their trust.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist elders getting in and out of the vehicle
- A keen ability to treat clients in a courteous and respectful manner
- Maintain privacy of clients transported to and from scheduled appointments
- Ensure LFN vehicles are used only for authorized transport
- Drive in a responsible, safe manner and comply with all applicable legislation while operating LFN vehicles
- Have good conflict management skills to navigate through sudden mishaps
- Clean vehicles after each use, ensuring all garbage is properly disposed of
- Maintain a full tank of gas after each trip
- Document and attend to routine maintenance and safety checks of the LFN vehicles
- Report all accidents/incidents which occur while on duty

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Knowledge of Nlaka'pamux culture and history
- Provide a current RCMP criminal record check with the vulnerable sector
- Valid Class 4 BC driver's license (or willing to take class 4 training)
- Current driver's abstract

- First Aid Certificate, with Basic Life Support (BLS) and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Certificate
