## Employment Opportunity Drug and Alcohol Support Worker

### Summary:

The Drug and Alcohol Support Worker will provide addiction support services to vulnerable and at-risk individuals and families within the Lytton First Nation (LFN) community. The role includes one on one sessions, treatment planning, referrals, and facilitating prevention and post-treatment services. This position promotes healing, wellness, and self-reliance using both traditional and contemporary approaches.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Provide individual and family support sessions (in-person/virtual)
- Develop, implement, and monitor client-specific work and wellness plans
- Offer pre-treatment, detox, treatment, and post-treatment support
- Facilitate workshops and wellness initiatives
- Conduct assessments, develop client histories, and complete referrals
- Maintain thorough documentation and monthly reports
- Collaborate with Health Team, community agencies, and support services
- Engage in community education and outreach activities
- Support clients through their healing journey with cultural sensitivity

### Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education or relevant experience in addictions, mental health, or social services
- Knowledge of intergenerational trauma, family violence, and First Nations health issues
- Strong interpersonal, counselling, communication, and documentation skills
- Experience in workshop facilitation and case management
- Proficient with MS Office
- Must pass a vulnerable sector criminal record check
- Valid driver's license
- Knowledge of Nlaka'pamux culture and willingness to learn and work
