Evacuation Order

Pursuant to Nlaka'pamux jurisdiction and the authority of Lytton First Nation Chief and Council, the **Evacuation Order** for fire V11337 Kookipi Creek wildfire is being issued due to immediate danger to life and safety due to an uncontrolled wildfire to include the following Indian Reserves:

**KITZOWIT IR20, LYTTON 26A, SKWAYANOPE 26,
LYTTON 31, NIKEYEAH 25**

**YOU MUST LEAVE THESE AREAS
IMMEDIATELY**

Evacuation Route:

Westside evacuation route is north to Lytton via the reaction ferry or over the spur bridge. Due to the K71634 fire, the evacuation route north to Lillooet via the North Spencer road may not be passable.

Kitzowit evacuation route is north on Highway 1 or Highway 12

If you have to evacuate:

- Take an emergency survival / grab and go kit with you.
- Make sure you take prescription medicines and identification for the entire family.
- Listen to the radio and follow instructions from local emergency officials.
- If you are instructed to do so, shut off water, gas and electricity.
- Make arrangements for your pets. Local emergency officials will advise you.
- Wear cloths and shoes appropriate for the conditions.
- Shut your windows and lock your home.
- Follow the routes specified by emergency officials. Don't take shortcuts. A shortcut could take you to a blocked or dangerous area.
- If you have time, contact others family members letting them know when you left and where you went.
- If you are evacuated, register with the local ESS emergency reception center closest to you.

EVERY ATTEMPT WILL BE MADE TO PROVIDE AS MUCH ADVANCE NOTICE AS POSSIBLE SHOULD AN EVACUATION BE REQUIRED. CHANGING WEATHER CONDITIONS HOWEVER MAY RESULT IN LITTLE OR NO NOTICE.

BE PREPARED !

This evacuation alert will remain in force until further notice, unless cancelled by order of the Lytton First Nation.

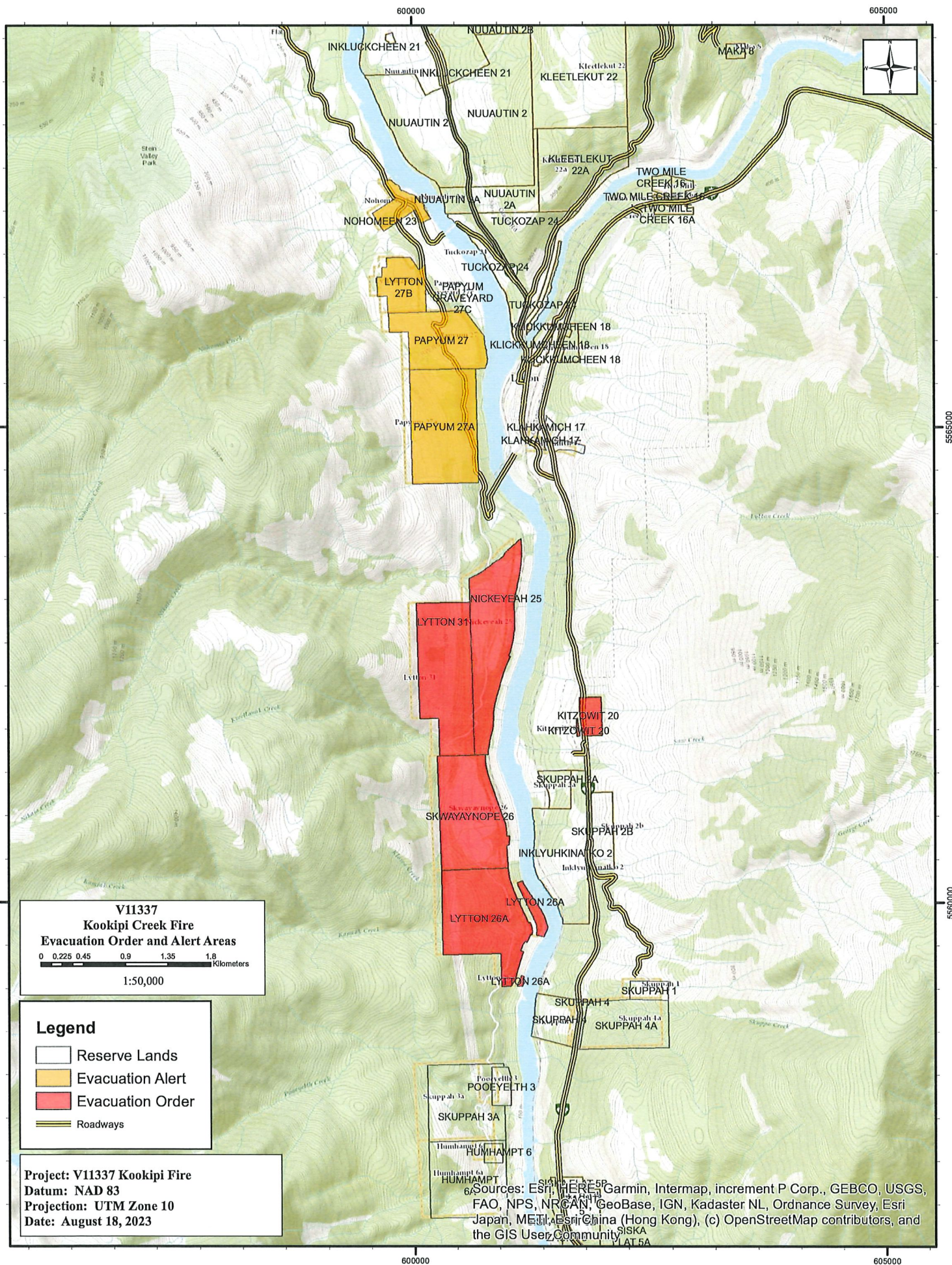
