Evacuation Order Rescind

Pursuant to Nlaka'pamux jurisdiction and the authority of Lytton First Nation Chief and Council, an Evacuation Order was put in place July 14, 2022, due to immediate danger to life and safety caused by an uncontrolled wildfire in the area.

That the Lytton First Nation Chief and Council now rescind the Evacuation Order July 14, 2022 be reduced to an Evacuation Alert the following reserves effective immediately.
