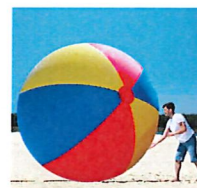

The month of June was a very busy month with Family and Friends, Graduation, Birthdays. I hope everyone is doing Great, Keeping Healthy. We need to Keep Safe, and to be Kind to Each Other, Everyone is hurting in different ways.

Currently I am out of laminate Cards, possibly for awhile. I am able to do the 5 year Secure Certificate of Indian Status for Children and 10 year for Adults Secure Certificate of Indian Status, this take exactly 3 month to come in. I do passport photos here only if you are local registered members. Please check your laminate cards for expired dates even if it is within 6 months call and I can prep your card. You still require two (2) Identification for adults signing for children one (1) is required and they must be original copied, not expired. Parents please ensure that you have the updated Health Care Card, it is called BC Service Card.

It is very important that I receive copies of Death Certificate of your Beloved family member, Marriage Certificate, there are important factors for these to be filed at Indian Affairs, Death Certificate to be removed from the band registry, for funding purposes. Marriage Registration for Medical, Dental reason, so that the Government is not paying for both under single, once married can be paid under one.

I have been asking at Indian Affairs they mentioned that if I do more 5/10 year SCIS that they would put more funds into the membership program, as I have done approximately 500 still no increase so than they asked me who's I have done, I had to try to retract the names, than they informed me only from 2021!

Now I am saving my list as I go along again in a safe place to send it to Indian Affairs.

Please call to start your 5/10 year SCIS.

Newsletter submission from LFN Economic Development Department

Agriculture

Yekm will be preparing a submission to Agriculture and Agri0-Food Canada under the local Food Infrastructure Fund (LFIF). We will be submitting a proposal to assist Yekm to develop additional farmland and also to seek funds for Equipment, Seeds, and Freezer Units that we presently do not already have under other Federal and Provincial Programs.

On June 28, 2022 we received visitors Indigenous Business Agriculture, Erica Nitchie. United Way of B. C. Ryan Deneault. Ministry of Agriculture Fisheries and Food, Food Innovation (Food Hubs), Ministry of Agriculture, Indigenous and Entrepreneur Services, Dennis Jess, Sophie Palmer Counselling, Sophia Palmer, Shulus Gardens, Chris Doucette, and Lorna Shuter. This group came to visit the Yekm Food Hub Garden and we showed them around and explained to them where we planned to plant the large garden this year. We also explained where we planned to place one large greenhouse and one smaller greenhouse. They were impressed by what they saw and our plans for the future. A good job to Paula Cranmer-Underhill and the Garden Crew.

Irrigation Ditches

We are working on a submission to the LFN Chief and Council in order to present our findings on LFN Irrigation ditches that require attention. We have many ditches that require extensive work on them. The Skwaynope ditch requires digging out and also work to divert back into the ditch from above the B.C. Hydro power line. The 18 Mile ditch requires very extensive work on flumes, support structures, and culverts that have rusted away over the years. The Alkali ditch requires extensive work due to the fire, slides, and other challenges. There is a real need to apply for a "change of works" so that the water rights from the lower ditch that previously serviced farms and the St. George's lands. I believe that the lower ditch may take precedence over other water licenses along the Bootanie Ditch. We would be recommending that funds for these upgrades be obtained from the Indian Affairs Trust Funds. Chief and Council have stated that each ditch requires a "champion" that checks the ditch on a regular basis and makes sure that any problems are repaired.

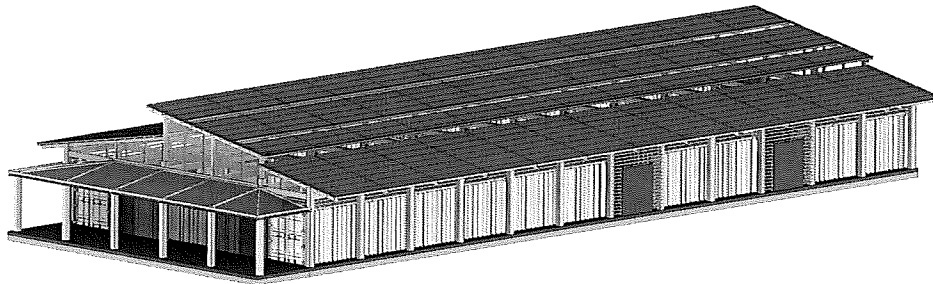

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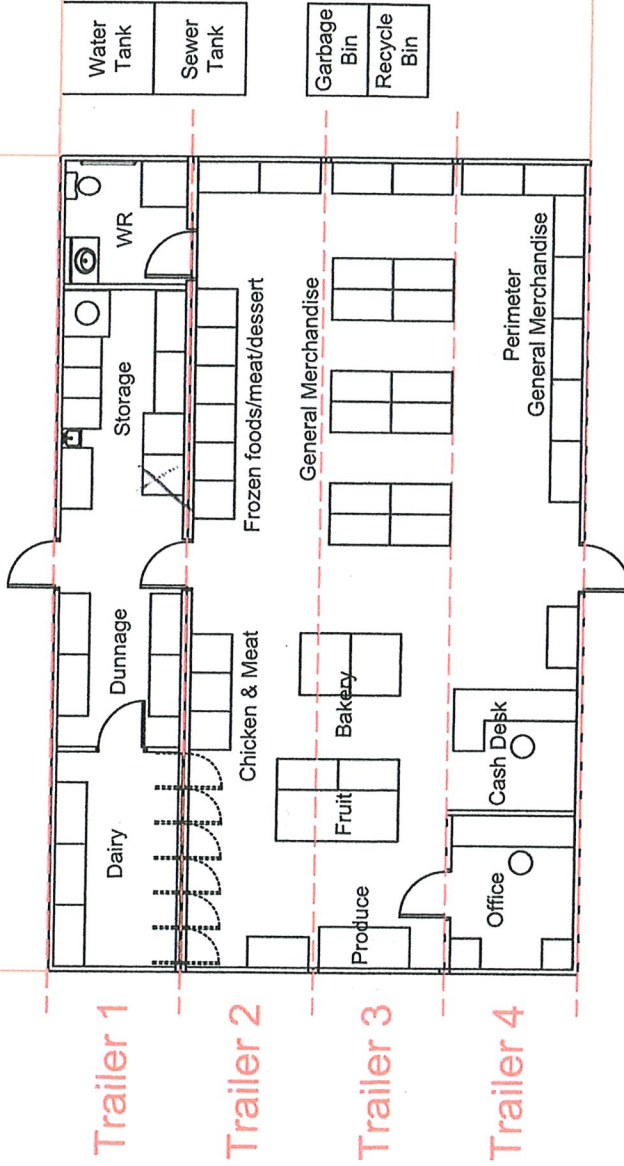

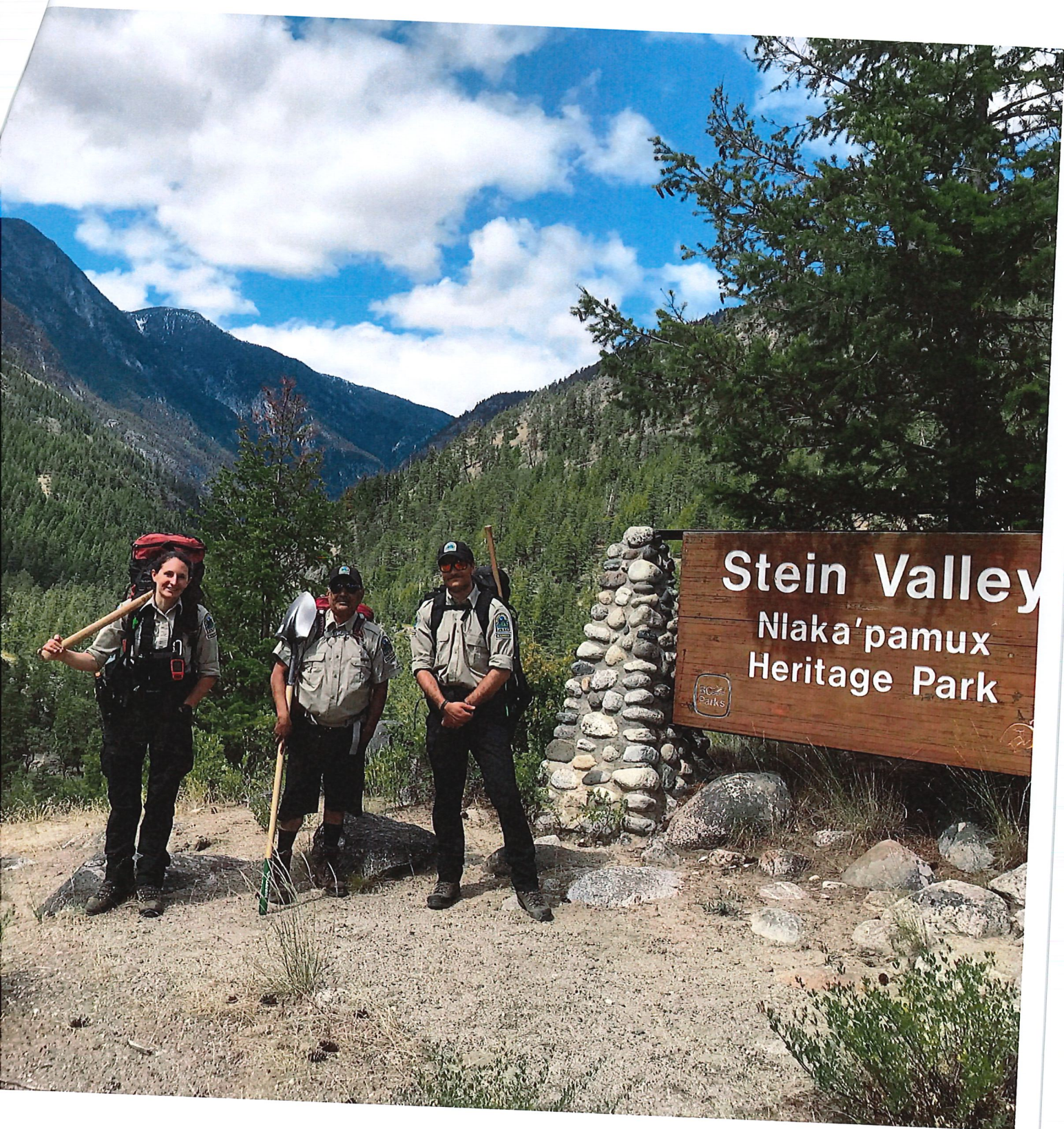

My heartfelt prayers and best wishes go out to all who suffering losses.

Looking back over the month of June I have seen the hard work of our leadership, staff and contractors hard work start falling together. It is only the beginning for us to come back stronger, but we need to do it together with one heart and one mind. It is so uplifting to see smiles and hearing laughter in our community.

We are still having difficulty in finding land to place our temporary homes and services on. This is due to the many CP holders, the terrain, Archeological sites and most important access to sufficient water. I would like to continue to encourage members to share thoughts and ideas regarding how we can possibly solve some of these barriers. This has been on the table for several month and still have only had 1 response from community.

FIRESMART

We have some Firesmart initiatives in the works, one of which is having home assessments done on each of the existing homes, we anticipate the work will start the 3rd week in July and it will be posted on face book when we will be in your area.

IMMEDIATE NEEDS

For our immediate needs we are still looking for land to place a temporary community hall, possible firehall, and a warehouse for a relief centre.

ESSENTIAL SERVICES

RCMP

The temporary RCMP which will be located at the old hospital site has still not arrived yet as they had to look for a new facility to move here. Still hoping to have construction started in September

CANADA POST

We are so happy to announce that our Temporary Post Office is now open for business. The Grand Opening took place on July 05, 2022 with over 100 people stopping by to pick up their new keys. Each person with a box number is given 1-2 keys, the post office does not have additional keys so if they are lose it is up to the person to pay to have a locksmith come in to replace the lock. The post office will be fully functionable by the end of the week. The Senior Postal Staff is looking into re-establishing deliveries from Amazon.

BC AMBULANCE

We are still looking at late fall to have the permanent Ambulance Station in place. Remember we do have full Ambulance service in Lytton which is based out of TI'kemtsin Community Health Centre.

LAND CODE

We are still hoping to bring the Land Code to a vote in October, 2022.

You will be seeing and hearing about how and why it is important by zoom meetings, flyers, posters and when the pandemic constraints lift in person community engagement. Valerie and Murray Sam are taking the lead on this exciting opportunity to move towards taking control of our own land and move away from the constraints of the Indian Act.

We continue to ask members to help us to identify any new dump sites, environmental hazards etc within the last 5 years we would appreciate your help in locating these. Pictures and location will be very helpful. Thank you.

TELUS

We still continue to have Telus vehicles in our community. We are happy to announce that we will be getting TELUS Pure Fibre Optic Network throughout our community. Telus and Lytton First Nation are presently working on designs of the poles will need to be placed and permits. We will be in touch with CP holders individually who will be involved with this process. I am attaching the information once again for your review.

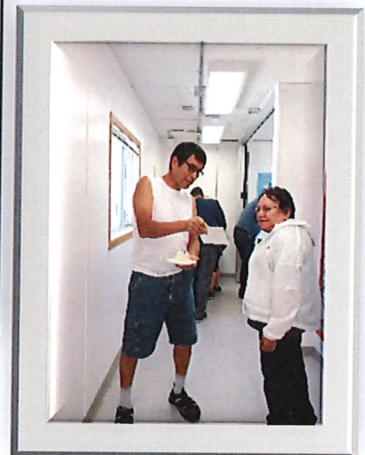

Hello Lytton First Nation Community members from your LFN Health Team. These have been some trying times in our health department, through this recovery from the wildfire, but we are making great progress in providing essential health services back to the Lytton community. Discussions on acquiring more enhanced health services for the area is ongoing but progressing nicely with our partners.

We are very pleased to have our health staff back to their prior health positions. We would like to thank our health staff, for really stepping up and into important roles that provided essential services to our community, immediately after the fire and into recovery. Health staff were also critical in working to prepare the TI'kemtsin facility, for use by LFN Health, FNHA, Interior Health, and BC Ambulance Service. We are extremely proud of the staff roles, in our community's desperate time of need. We've had to make some difficult decisions to provide effective health services to the Lytton area.

Some of our regular staff were relocated to accommodate the reestablishment of primary health services in the Lytton area. Chief Janet Webster has reiterated from the beginning, our commitment to all of Lytton, through this disaster, as we have always been one community. These Primary Care services were established in the spirit of the commitment letters and were made available to all of Lytton and surrounding communities. We are very proud of the teamwork and dedication it took from our health staff and agency partners, to get these services established.

With our evacuees returning to the community in the near future to their interim housing, our health staff will be coordinating closely with the EOC Liaisons to ensure a smooth transition back into the community and health supports.

With the re-establishment of primary care services, and our staff returning, our health team and agency partners, are now focusing our attention on enhanced mental health supports, as outlined in the commitment letters. LFN Health is also in discussions to provide interim laboratory services out of the TI'kemtsin Health Center and will keep the community updated on these discussions.

We would lastly, like to thank our community members for their patience and understanding through this trying time. We are all in this together and unity is what will get us the rest of the way. Thank you!
