Lytton First Nation (LFN) is looking for a sincere, energetic and caring home support worker. Working under the support and supervision provided by the Health Manager and the Social Development Manager, the Home Support Worker provides in-home support to Elders and individuals with disabilities to help them maintain a clean, safe, and comfortable living environment. This position focuses on assisting clients with basic household tasks and promoting independence and dignity in daily living.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform light housekeeping duties such as sweeping, mopping, dusting, vacuuming, laundry, and changing bed linens
- Support clients in maintaining an organized and sanitary home environment
- Observe and report any changes in the client's condition or home situation
- Build positive, respectful relationships with clients based on trust, cultural sensitivity, and compassion
- Follow all health, safety, and confidentiality guidelines

JOB SKILLS:

- Experience working with Elders or people with disabilities is an asset
- Reliable, compassionate, and respectful attitude toward clients; Strong work ethic and a positive team attitude
- Must be able to perform light physical tasks (e.g., lifting laundry, bending, standing)
- Valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation may be required
- High School Diploma or GED
- Experience in community health prevention and promotion programs (an asset but not required)
- First Aid/CPR or willingness to get certified
- Able to work independently with little or no supervision and provide good client care
