Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Plays alongside others.
- Seeks out others to share experiences.
- Responds to a few appropriate boundaries, with encouragement and support.
- Begins to learn that some things are theirs, some things are shared, and some things belong to other people.

Understanding the World

- Is curious about people and shows interest in stories about themselves and family members.
- Matches parts of objects that fit together, e.g. puts a lid on a teapot.
- In pretend play, imitates everyday actions and events from own family cultural background, e.g. making coffee.
- Seeks to acquire basic skills in turning on and operating some ICT equipment.

Mathematics

- Recognises big and small things in meaningful contexts.
- Counts to 3 or beyond.
- Attempts and successfully fit shapes into spaces on puzzles or inset board.
- Anticipates specific time-based events such as mealtimes or home time.

December After School Club Activities

Expressive Art and Design

- Notices and is interested in the effects of making movements which leave marks.
- Experiments with blocks, colours and marks.
- Join in singing favourite songs.
- Creates sounds by banging, shaking, tapping.

Physical Development

- Shows some awareness of bladder and bowel urges and may know what potty or toilet is used for.
- Can put and take coat off and shows desire to help with dressing or undressing.
- Feeds self competently with spoon and drinks without spilling.
- Climbs confidently and is beginning to pull themselves up on a climbing frame equipment.

Communication and Language / Literacy

- Has some favourites songs or stories.
- Repeats words or phrases from familiar stories or songs.
- Understands simple sentences, e.g. Throw the ball.
- Rigid attention may appear not to hear.
- Beginning to put two words together, e.g. more water.
- Begin to ask questions.
