Bidders shall have the ability to initially deliver 200 towels to the facility, and on a weekly basis evenly exchange the used towels with new towels and deliver clean mats and runners.

Bidder shall also be responsible for all fuel costs, lubrication, and equipment maintenance costs that are incurred while providing this service for KRMA.
