Regular Monthly Meeting**

**Held at Sangamon Township Building, 1264 Old Rt 47 White Heath Illinois**

***February 8, 2018***

*Minutes*

The regular monthly meeting of Sangamon Township was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Kathleen Piatt. Roll call was taken. Kathleen Piatt, Mike Nolan, Bill Olson and Steve Harper were present. John Foley was absent.

Debbie Marshall-Clerk, Brent Buckalew-Assessor and Larry Sebens-Highway Commissioner were also present.

The pledge of allegiance was recited.

**Public Comment:**

None

**Minutes:**

A motion to approve and accept the regular monthly January minutes was made by Steve Harper and seconded by Mike Nolan. The minutes were unanimously approved.

**Invoices:**

A motion to approve invoices was made by Bill Olson and seconded by Steve Harper. With a roll call vote of 4 ayes and 0 nays, the motion to approve invoices passed.

**Announcements/communications:**

Kathleen has a General Assistance training workshop approaching. T.O.I. Trustees membership is due. A motion to pay this membership fee and cover the payment for the workshop was made by Mike Nolan and seconded by Bill Olson. All were in favor. A Senior Share Fair will be held in April at the White Heath Community Building. There will be vendors with information for Seniors. Kathleen contacted Young's to obtain a cost quote for curbside recycling with no response. Knight reports that newspaper & cardboard is being recycled. Some of the aluminum is sold to a recycle company. Mike prepared a grant application to Illinois Department of Resources in order to receive funding for the land in the park project. Kirby Ambulance Service sent us a bill. Kathleen asked them to come & speak at our March meeting to explain the

services they offer. In April Kathleen would like Frannie to give a presentation to the Board about the cemeteries, records and needs of each cemetery in the Township. Mike shared a “letter to the editor” regarding support of Township government.

**Old Business:**

The current financial report was passed out for review. Also, the tentative 2018 Budget and Appropriations for Township and Road District was distributed to the Board for study. It will be voted on at the March meeting.

Township cleanup days will be April 20<sup>th</sup> 8-3 and April 21<sup>st</sup> 8-12.

**New Business:**

A motion to move to closed session to discuss a legal matter was made by Mike Nolan and seconded by Bill Olson. All were in favor.

Open session resumed at 8:10.
