The regular meeting of Sangamon Township was called to order at 7PM. Roll call was taken, Steve Harper, Jim Hogan, Elsie Robinson, Lynn Hiser and Ray Spencer all present. A safety moment was taken and the Pledge was recited. Public comment: K. Piatt stated that she would suggest that we take the sunset clause out of the Land Use document. January minutes were read and Steve Harper made a motion to approve and Ray Spencer second. The bills were reviewed approved to pay with a motion from Jim Hogan and second by Steve Harper. Ray passed everyone a Budget and Appropriation to review. TOI has state there is an open meetings informational review on the website that everyone has to complete by 1/31/2013. If you don't have a computer there is one at the township that we can make arrangements so you can use it. Ray made mention that we will have to complete the agenda for the town meeting in the March meeting. Ray contacted the school concerning the recycle, they state that they have minimal boxed that they use it for. No mention of donations. Brent Buckalew brought copies of the salary survey for officials in surrounding townships and mentioned that there are scholarships available through TOI. Golf cart signs- Steve will call Randy Keith to see if anything had been decided about golf cart signs. Ray will check with Foltz about one or the other, posting in paper or signs. Clean up days- it was decided that we did it last year and will skip 2012. Lynn Hiser made a motion to adopt the Land Usage Commission Ordinance. Elsie Robinson second. All were in favor. Mowing contract is due. A motion was made by Steve Harper and second by Elsie Robinson to put an ad in the paper to except bids for mowing the ball diamond, township office and recycle area. They will need proof of insurance in a sealed bid to be received by March 8. Steve Harper made a motion to adjourn and Elsie Robinson second.
