The regular meeting of Sangamon Township was called to order at 7 p.m. Roll call was taken, Elsie Robinson, Ray Spencer, Jim Hogan, John Foley all present, Steve Harper absent.

A Safety Moment was taken as well as the Pledge of Allegiance being recited.

Public comment was opened. Rick Harper stated that the pole light looks good and gives off nice light. Steve Long brought the concern of closing White Heath School to the attention of the board. He would like to see the board take interest in this situation and fight to keep it open. He also feels that the Township should have a booth type table at the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and maybe even host a White Heath Celebration.

Elsie Robinson made a motion to except the January 2013 minutes with the correction of reviewing the Budget, not voting on the Budget, second by Jim Hogan.

Elsie Robinson made a motion to except the bills as paid second by Jim Hogan.

Ray Spencer informed the board that to add another light pole at the end, near the drive, would cost about \$2500. Board will discuss when Steve Harper returns. A suggestion of maybe just a sign that says Township Entrance at the end would help.

Mowing Bid – Discussion about the bid and how to handle mowing for summer of 2013 was discussed. A suggestion of using our own equipment and paying Franny to mow the ball field and Township office was made, and then asking the Road Commissioner take care his building area that would need mowed. Item will be placed on the agenda for next month.

Budget – A copy of the Budget will be posted on the website, per Ray Spencer it is basically the same as last year.

Elsie Robinson made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Jim Hogan.
