Melissa Chitwood announce Guns VS Hoses to off ball season on May 14 and questioned if any discussion of fryers in concessions. Melanie Perry had questions about homes for sale on our website and maybe a double check before things are posted. Kathleen Piatt comment she was glad we kept clean up days and Sharon Martian agreed. Ray made a motion to adjourn and Jim second.
