The regular meeting of Sangamon Township was called to order at 7:05. April minutes were approved. Bills were read and approved. Larry Sebens stated Open Road is storing road millings on his lot in exchange for a couple of tons. Brent Buckalew commented he is almost done assessing. Lynn Hiser stated wind damage to the ball diamond, visitors dug out. He had three quotes with one being S&K being the best. Steve Harper made a motion to excerpt S&K quote to repair the roof and Ray Spencer second. All were in favor. Melissa Chitwood was waiting on a call from WHRL insurance and then will weigh out the options of its worth the cost of having a fryer. Lynn Hiser mentions an error on the SS Taxes, it has been corrected. The website- Ray Spencer made a proposal of new guidelines. After reviewing, Ray Spencer made a motion for the following guidelines: 1-The site will be limited to official township business, i.e., township officials, meeting, agendas, minutes, assessor, highway commissioner, cemeteries, and recycling program. 2- The following section will be deleted: bulletin boards, parks, homes for sale. 3-The land marks section will remain but renamed "township photos". Photos in this section may be added or deleted at the discretion of the webmaster without prior approval from the township trustees and supervisor. (the intent is to expand the range of photos that might be posted, e.g., photos of clean up days).4- The webmaster will clarify the registration of the domain. (Sangamon Twp.org) It should be registered to the township. 5-All future additions and changes to the site format or design must be pre-approved by the trustees and Supervisor. Steve Harper Second. All in favor. Per Melanie Perry we should be able to change it with a form from Go Daddy signed by and notarized. Clean up days-total 1318.17, we brought in 340.20 from scrap metal. Ray Spencer made a motion to split between WHRL and the community Club, Steve Harper second. All in favor. Elsie Robinson made a motion to review Clean Up days in January of each year to decide if we will have it for the current year. Ray Spencer Second. All in favor. Discussion on maintenance of yard and up keep of bleachers etc for the ball diamond. Ray Spencer made a motion to except the ball park lease with the stipulation of proof that they are non for profit corporation. Elsie Robinson second. All in favor. Melissa Chitwood asked the board to consider a flag pole at the ball diamond. Elsie Robinson has done some research but no prices. Lynn Hiser will talk to some schools and parks to see what they suggest. Ray Spencer commented that they had a cemetery meeting. Frannie Dick mentioned extra help for the summer and how he has paid them from his check before but asked for putting them on payroll or giving his an increase to pay them. Melissa Chitwood stated the creek by the ball diamond, the bank is washing away, its about 2 ft from fence. Larry Sebens is to go look at it. Steve Harper made motion to adjourn, Elsie Robinson second. All in favor.
