

**Sangamon Township  
Regular Monthly Meeting**

*Minutes*

The regular monthly meeting of Sangamon Township was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Ray Spencer. Roll call was taken. Elsie Robinson, Ray Spencer, John Foley, Bill Olson and Steve Harper were present.

John asked for a monthly fund report. Ray will discuss the possibility of creating these reports from our existing Quick books system with our C.P.A.

Bill asked Larry about plans to repair a bridge and road near his home.

Brent is looking forward to comparing our assessed values in December.

Elsie says that the Zoning policy review is coming along slowly.

Ray mentioned the idea of closing some old fund savings accounts that generate little interest and rolling the money into our existing checking accounts. This will also eliminate possible dormant account fees. The board felt that this is a good idea.

The abandoned house near Steve has been purchased. The new owner has plans to demolish the building.
