The annual Town meeting of Sangamon Township was called to order at 7 pm. We said the Pledge to the Flag and nominations were open for moderator. Ray Spencer nominated Rick Harper, Judy Harper second, and all were in favor. Changes to the 2010 Town meeting minutes were changed as follows: WHRL had 125 kids for baseball/softball, not basketball. Ra made a motion to except minutes with changes. Judy Harper second. It shows officials, minutes, agendas, land marks, and email address. She going to start on a 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary page soon. Melanie Perry asked about the host name and who its under. It is in Sally Nolans name. Melanie stated since it is an official sight it should be in the Township name. Melanie also asked about "homes for sale" and doesn't think that should be on the page. Lynn comment that it will discussed at the next meeting. Melissa Chitwood mentioned the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual MDA marble run on the May 28, 2011. Brent Buckalew said lots of new properties in our township, Kirby Court has 4 new homes, Shandy Lane has 2. We had more building permits than Monticello this last year. Rick Harper praised the WHRL for our ball diamond. He took his tractor down and helped out and everyone worked hard and they should be proud. Melissa Chitwood made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Elsi Robinson second, all were in favor.
