Regular Meeting Minutes
January 6, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Mike Nolan at 6:30 pm. Roll call was taken. Present were Supervisor Nolan and Trustees Bill Blickhan, Tim King and Kathleen Piatt. Also present were Highway Commissioner Larry Sebens and Clerk Kevin Duff. Absent was Trustee Tosha Valentine. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. No public comment was made.

Supervisor Nolan provided information to the Board that scholarships are available for high school seniors. Available seminars for Township officials are posted online at TOI. Township insurance was reviewed and changes made to some of the estimated values. Commissioner Sebens will review the Road assets values. Clerk Duff reminded the Board that the State's Economic Interest forms will be issued soon and need to be completed and returned to the County Clerk by the end of February.

A motion was made by Trustee King and seconded by Trustee Blickhan to approve the minutes from last month's meeting. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee Piatt to approve the invoices. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

The amount personally spent last Halloween by Commissioner Sebens was \$300. A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee Piatt to approve a line item in the Road budget for \$500 for next year's Halloween community outreach. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

The one-time annual general assistance recommended by TOI is \$456. The Township's maximum one-time general assistance is currently \$450. A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee King to approve one-time annual general assistance maximum at \$456. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

No Parks report was given. No news yet about the IDNR request for future Park improvements.

Discussion about the Camp Creek Cemetery tree work was deferred until next month.

The Road Budget was reviewed and suggested changes offered. The tentative Road Budget and tentative Town Budget will be reviewed next month.

Transfers were reviewed.

Final tax payment distributions were summarized.

A positive financial projection was given.

A summary of the Illinois Fund transactions was given.

Supervisor Nolan will ask Accountant Kelly if a balance sheet for the Road and Bridge accounts can be run like the income statement. The Board will review the current accounting reports next month to see if all of them are still needed.

A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee Piatt to adjourn the meeting. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
