

Sangamon Township Regular Meeting Minutes
April 8, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Trustee Kathleen Piatt as acting Supervisor for Supervisor Mike Nolan at 6:30 p.m. Roll call was taken. Present were Trustees Kathleen Piatt, Tosha Valentine, Tim King, and Bill Blickhan. Absent was Supervisor Nolan. Also present were Pat Gleason and Clerk Kevin Duff.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

No public comments were made.

Under new business, Mr. Gleason, president of the White Heath rec League, gave a status report for the league. A certificate of insurance was provided with the Township named as an additional insured. Sign-up for summer baseball teams is in the middle of happening. Numbers look good. The backstop will be installed as weather permits. Existing dug out roofs have issues. Repairs may be made this year. The park shelter also needs repair. Last year some of the bleacher boards were replaced. Some of the existing fence is curling up and will be tied down. Volunteers are to paint the shed. No information is available yet about having a fun day at the park. The league has a new web site that makes registration and payment easier. The Board noted that new "no parking" signs will be installed, A motion was made by Trustee King and seconded by Trustee Blickhan to approve a diagram of the "no parking" signs. A voice vote was taken and the motion was approved unanimously. The league is still working on getting tax free status from the State. The order of Board priority for new projects at the new diamond are fences to be installed, new dug outs and having a well installed. A search for a grant will be made for the well. The Board signed a thank you card for the anonymous donor of a \$75k donation to for improvements to the ball diamonds.

Under announcements, Trustee Piatt reported that starting in April, Road Commissioner Larry Sebens is receiving his annual 3% pay raise and that will be paid from the Permanent Road Fund.

The bank is now charging \$32 for stopping a check. The last 3 stopped checks were reversed but the new policy is something to be considered. The new policy seems to be consistent with other banks.

The final check from the State from the grant for park improvements has been received. The check was \$9,216.39.

A check for Overhead Doors will be reissued. The reduction in the equipment account was made before the check cleared.

Once the new fence is installed, additional insurance coverage for the new shed at the ball diamond and the fence will be made by Supervisor Nolan.

A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee Valentine to approve last month's meeting minutes. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Trustee King and seconded by Trustee Valentine to approve the invoices. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Duff is still working on setting up a meeting for possible Camp Creek Cemetery improvements.

The annual Town meeting is to be held at 7:00 pm April 14, 2026, at the Township Office Building. The Treasurer's report approved by the Board will be given at the Town meeting.

Supervisor Nolan and Clerk Duff have been pulling data for the auditor and should be delivered to the auditor at the end of April. In reconciling payments made last year, a couple of checks were not cashed and a couple of checks were not attested.

A cash flow projection prepared by Supervisor Nolan was distributed. The Town funds are currently right on as projected last month. The corrections made to the Road and Bridge Fund during the second period have been corrected in this report from \$35,338.52 to \$60,574.84.

The Board commented that having a schedule and locations from Road Commissioner Sebens for this year's road repairs would be helpful.

A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee Valentine to adjourn the meeting. A voice vote was taken and the motion was approved unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm.
