

Sangamon Township Regular Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order By Supervisor Mike Nolan at 6:30 p.m. Roll call was taken. Present were Supervisor Nolan and Trustees Bill Blickhan, Tim King and Tosha Valentine. Also present were Highway Commissioner Larry Sebens and Clerk Kevin Duff. Absent was Trustee Kathleen Piatt. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Supervisor Nolan distributed a copy of an e mail about new state laws taking effect or being considered. We will wait until after tax season to ask Kelly's Accounting about any new financial reports. TOIRMA dividends were received and distributed.

A motion was made by Trustee Valentine and seconded by Trustee Blickhan to approve the minutes. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Trustee King and seconded by Trustee Valentine to approve the invoices. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Blickhan read the Town Budget resolution for 2026 and made a motion seconded by Trustee Valentine to approve the resolution and ordinance. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Valentine read the Road and Bridge resolution for 2026 and made a motion seconded by Trustee King to approve the resolution and ordinance. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed last year's Annual Town Meeting agenda. A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee Valentine to approve the agenda for 2026 as amended. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

A discussion was had about planting a screen around the ball diamond but waiting until water is available. Some suggestions were made for Hicks yews or an ornamental grass. The Rec League representatives will come to next month's meeting.

A motion was made by Trustee Blickhan and seconded by Trustee King to lease the farm ground at the Park in 2026 to Dan Davis with the same terms as 2025. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Duff will set a meeting at Camp Creek Cemetery with Sexton Frannie Dick, Highway Commissioner Larry Sebens and Gus Hatch to discuss tree removal.

The Monticello Sign Shop will send the Township a statement for a pizza donation from the Township to thank the students for making the Park sign.

Interest rates for the Illinois Fund are going down.

Replacement tax has been received but is getting smaller.

A positive cash flow projection was distributed for the Town and Road and Bridge budgets.

A motion was made by Trustee King and seconded by Trustee Valentine to adjourn the meeting. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
