NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- To participate, dogs must be at least 6 months old. Spayed, neutered, limited registration, FSS, PAL and ILP dogs of eligible breeds may participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules.
- *Dogs ineligible for entry* include deaf or blind dogs and dogs owned/co-owned by the test judge or family. Bitches in season shall not be eligible.
- Entry fees will not be refunded for bitches in season.

Arizona Earthdog Club offers a ribbon to each dog that earns a qualifying score in a class. Rosettes will be offered to any dog that finishes a title. Dog toys will be offered to each dog that qualifies. A piece of dachshund memorabilia is offered to each dachshund that qualifies in a regular class. Donated by Fernande Hasert Kuykendall



RUNNING ORDER:

The running order will be based on the order in which entries are received, except Master, where dogs are braced by random draw. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to be aware of the posted running order. Dogs not present when called will be moved to the end of the running order.

- Pre-entry fees will not be refunded after March 22, 2023.
- Day-of-Test entries will not be refunded, regardless of circumstances.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE:

From I-17 North or South

Exit at Exit 289, W. Middle Verde Rd, Camp Verde

Turn West onto W. Middle Verde Rd.

Turn South onto N. Verde River Dr. - then West onto Reservation Loop Rd.

Follow Reservation Loop Rd. to Jackpot Ranch on the left: 2025 Reservation Loop Rd.

From entrance: Follow the entrance road straight ahead, past the rodeo grounds and pastures, to the end and through a gate. The test site is at the end of the road, under the trees.
