We're proud to announce that John Haynes is our Elks Lodge "Veteran of the Month" for August 2025. John Lodge began his military journey with basic and advanced individual training at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, where he became a 12B Combat Engineer.

*** He was stationed in Baumholder, Germany, for three years, excelling in his 1PT and 11383 track tests—the top scores in his battalion. This achievement earned him the honor of participating in the Liberation of Southern France, where he carried the French flag in several parades. John returned to Germany in 1985 and was assigned an 11A3 Armored Personnel Carrier and a "Hum V" (High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle). He returned to the United States to complete his service in the Utah National Guard, serving there for seven years.


