board in the social club. I hope to see you all at these events and that you enjoy the rest of your summer!

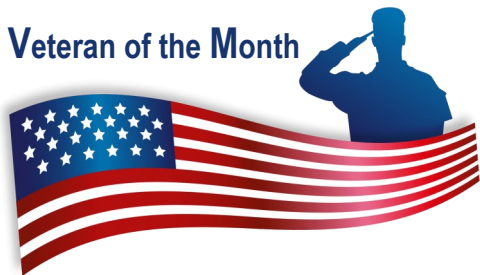
