



Bomb It Golf Rules and Regulations:

- 1.) Dress Code – All participants must meet the minimum dress code enforced by the local course to play. No Blue Jeans, Cutoffs, Tee Shirts (Including Tank tops)
- 2.) Rules of play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.
 - a. Local Rule – Out of Bounds: Out of Bounds local ruling allows the player to take the ball to the nearest point of relief in the fairway no closer to the hole drop and assume a 2 (two) stroke penalty. The option to play the standard out of bounds penalty of “Stroke and Distance” is always an available option.
 - b. Lost Balls will be played by the USGA rules and require “stroke and distance”
 - c. Triple Bogey Max
 - d. In some cases, local rules may be implemented so please refer to the tournament rule sheets for each individual event to verify if indeed there are in “local” rules in play for the event.
- 3.) Any Rules disputes will be managed by a Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour official or local professional from the course we are playing. Rulings are final and the decision will stand as is.
- 4.) Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour was designed with fun in mind, and we hope all participants keep this in mind. We also know that competition can breed hostilities. Any act of violence or hostility towards another player, event coordinator, staff member or member club staff or member will result in disqualification and potentially removal from Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour. Multiple Infractions will lead to immediate dismissal from the event and the tour. Violent behavior will not be tolerated.
- 5.) Participants must be legal age to drive a golf cart no participant shall be below the age of 16 years old age 14 and 15 can play if accompanied by a guardian and player below the age of 18 will require the consent of a parent or legal guardian. There are no “Junior” Tees or Division players under 18 will be required to play the tees based on their handicaps and ability levels.
- 6.) Cheating is prohibited anyone caught cheating will be removed from the event. “Sand Bagging” by players can result in being removed from the tour.
- 7.) Handicaps will be evaluated by the Tour committee. GHIN handicap index is the preferred system for the B.I.G. Amateur Tour. Tour will accept other handicap information sources but reserves the right to change the handicap prior to the start of the event. In the event a handicap adjust occurs the player will have the option to remove themselves from the event prior to beginning the round/ event. If a player does not have an attestable handicap and cannot produce a legitimate handicap, they will be allowed to play in an event with a cap of 2 shots below the stated handicap. After the second event the tour will issue an appropriate handicap and the cap will be removed. The tour reserves the right to enforce a tournament handicap if felt there is a need to reduce a player based on event performance.
- 8.) The Bomb It Golf Staff Reserves the right to refuse entry into any event to any person at any time for failing to meet any of the above rule’s violations.



Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour Terms and Conditions:

By participating / entering and playing in a Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour tournament (“tournament”), I understand and agree that there are certain dangers involved with the participation in a golf tournament, including but not limited to being struck by lightning, getting hit by a golf club, suffering from heat exhaustion, heart attack or injury from uneven terrain, all of for which risks I assume and solely accept, and waives all claims of injury to body or property against Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour, sponsors, host course, owners, company officers, employees or volunteers. Further, I agree that while on the premises of a Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour tournament, I, and any guest, relative or anyone else affiliated me, shall be present at their own risk and that Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour, sponsors, host course, owners, company officers, employees or volunteers shall not be liable for any claims for injuries or damages whatsoever to person or property of the participant or related person arising out of or in connection with the participation in the tournament or presence at the tournament. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour, sponsors, host course, owners, company officers, employees, or volunteers from all claims by or liability to myself or affiliated person. I am hereby indicating that I understand all the information pertaining to tournament prizes, the Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour point system and all rules and instructions contained herein. I am hereby indicating that when registering for a Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour event, I understand all the information pertaining to tournament prizes and all rules and instructions contained herein. I understand that if I am unable to participate, I may be responsible for the tournament entry fees. I hereby hold harmless Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour, sponsors, host course, owners, company officers, employees or volunteers and its organizers from any and all liability for any loss or injury related to my attendance or participation in any Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour sanctioned event. I grant permission to the Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour and related entities to use or authorize others to use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of my participation in this event or related activities for any legitimate purpose without remuneration. I also understand that annual memberships are not refundable after participating in an event and are not refundable after 30 days regardless of participation.



Annual Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour Player of The Year Points Format:

Players will accumulate points over the course of the year from each event they participate in.

The Top 25% of the tour point earners will receive an award at the end of the season you will be able to check the website for the annual purse. This will be used for the season end awards. Each Season will end following the final tournament in November.

Points Pay Out As Follows: Based on the results of all members no matter the flights in the event (Non Member Results do not effect Member placement for POY Points):

1st Place – 12 Points

2nd Place – 10 Points

3rd Place – 9 Points

4th Place – 8 Points

5th Place 7 Points

6th Place – 6 Points

7th Place – 5 Points

8th Place – 4 Points

9th Place – 3 Points

10th thru Last – 2 Points

Tournament Prize Payouts are based on participation and flight size. Ideal flights would have 15 participants and based on a \$35 per player to the purse. \$30 would go towards the Flight Winners and \$5 per participant will go towards the Closest to the pin contests for the field on par three's The number of Closest to the Pin prizes will depend on participation.

And pay: (EXAMPLE BELOW BASED ON FULL 15 PLAYER FLIGHT)

1st Place - \$250.00

2nd Place - \$125.00

3rd Place - \$75.00

There will Be one \$50 Closest to the Pin Prize for every 10 Players in the field.

In the event a flight has less than 15 players the payouts will each be reduced to equal the purse for the day. In the event there is less than 10 players in a flight there will not be a 3rd place. For that event.



Note: Due to rules revolving around Amateur Status all Prizes award will have to be in the form of Gift Certificates. *Closest The Pin Paid Out*
