

Bomb It Golf Amateur Tour 2026

New Format for 2026 Play

Every Tour Event will be a Gross and Net Event the top players for each scoring method will be paid out:

The number of places paid in each division will be based on the total number of players in the event:

Payouts at each event will also be based on the number of players for the event.

\$50 from every entry fee is put into the purse at each event \$45 to the

Tournament Purse \$5 from every entry to the Closest to the Pin Purse.

Gross takes precedence over net score and no person can win both gross and net money in any event.

Example: Event has 36 players, the total purse for the event is \$1800

\$1620 will be split between the 2 divisions \$810 Gross and \$810 Net

\$180 will be divided by the number of par 3's on the course.

In this Case a player with a 3 handicap shoots 71 (-1) gross and 68 (-4) net

71 was the low Gross he will win 1st place gross 68 finished 3rd place net this person will not win the net spot. It will move to the next lowest net score.

In the case of 36 players The payout would be as follows in each Division (Gross and Net)

1st Place \$250, 2nd Place \$200, 3rd Place \$150, 4th place \$100,

5th place \$60, 6th Place \$50

Each Par three (if 4) would pay out \$45

Individual tournament purses will vary based on participation.

Every member playing in a B.I.G. event will receive \$50.00 (no cash value) towards their end of year money winnings total.

This year we will have the Player of the Year awarded to the Highest money winner after the completion of the Tour Championship. **The Tour Championship will be a tour members only event. The Top 2 moneyboard leaders after the last regular event will get a paid entry to the Tour Championship.**

POY Money will still be paid out to the to 25% of tour members based on their position on the money winnings leaderboard (Skins money will not be included in this)
