Requirements

To be eligible you must:

- Between the ages of 14 and 20
- Have parental permission if under 18 years of age
- Have good moral character
- Remain in school maintaining a C average or higher until graduation
- Provide two written references
- No criminal convictions
- Attend meetings on regular basis
- Attend Michigan Law Enforcement Youth Training Academy within two years of application
- Be willing to commit to Post Rules
- Exemplify the professional image of the Warren Police Department
